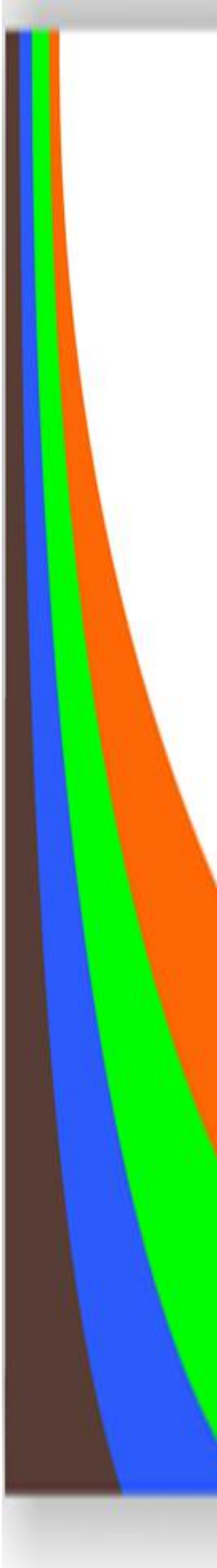


KVDA PLAZA

KVDA is one of the six Regional Development Authorities (RDAs) under the Ministry of East African Community and Regional Development. It was established in 1979 under Cap 441 of the Laws of Kenya and mandated to undertake River basin conservation and management through integrated river basin based Development programmes with the key objective of propelling development to improve the region's per capita income.

KVDA's area of jurisdiction is located in the North Western part of Kenya and lies between Latitudes $0^{\circ} 1^{\circ}$ South and $10^{\circ} 3^{\circ}$ North; and longitudes 34° and 37° East. The area which includes the Counties' of Baringo, Elgeyo-Marakwet, West Pokot, Turkana, Samburu and Nakuru is approximately **107,759.18** square Kilometers, representing 19% of the land mass of Kenya with over 80% being arid and semi-arid. The current population in KVDA's area of jurisdiction is 3,182,693 people (*2019 Population Census*).

The operational area is bounded by the drainage basins of Turkwel, Kerio Rivers and their tributaries which drain into Lake Turkana. Other drainage basins within the area include; Lakes Baringo and Bogoria drainage basin, Suguta - Lake Lokipi drainage basin and Tarach - Lotikipi drainage basin.
