1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background

Kerio Valley Development Authority (KVDA) is a state corporation under the Ministry of East African Community, ASALS, and Regional Development. It was established in 1979 under Cap 441 of the Laws of Kenya and mandated to undertake River basin conservation and management through integrated river basin-based development programmes with the key objective of propelling development to improve the region's per capita income. The Authority's operational area include the Counties of Baringo, Elgeyo-Marakwet, Uasin Gishu, West Pokot, Turkana, Samburu, and Nakuru. It covers a total area of 107,089 sq. km representing 18.3% of Kenya's landmass with a population of 3,548,071. Eighty percent (80%) of the area is arid and semi-arid.

The Authority leads in promoting sustainable, effective, and excellent utilization of natural resources in the region which include water, minerals, population, land, livestock, fisheries, and tourism-related resources.

2. Objective(s) of the Assignment

The objective of the assignment is to undertake:

- (i) Preliminary Engineering Design and Detailed Engineering Design;
- (ii) Update the environmental and social impact assessment and ESMP based on the detailed engineering designs;
- (iii) Tender document preparation and tender management;
- (iv) Supervision of the construction of the works, as well as management of the defect's liability period;

3. PROPOSED PROJECT SCOPE

The town's water supply is proposed to be augmented from the present rehabilitation work currently ongoing at the Yogot Dam site through construction of:

- Off-take works for gravity pipeline– 100m x 250 mm DN DF pipes
- Treatment works
- Rising main pipeline 2000m x 110mm dia. HDPE PN16 pipe
- Sub-Main pipeline 3600m x 110mm dia. HDPE PN16 pipe
- Solar pumping 1 no. solar driven pump capacity 20m³/hr

- Proposed 200 Ha lower catchment irrigation project
- Conservation of the Kessup Ecosystem

To undertake this, a detailed study is proposed that will culminate in design, tender document preparation and supervision of contract.

The duration of the assignment is expected to be Two (2) months during which the Consulting firm is expected to provide the services.

The Ministry of East African Community and Regional Development Authorities through KVDA now invites eligible consulting firms or consortia of firms ("consultant") to indicate their interest in providing the Consultancy services. Interested consultants must provide information in a short format demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to provide the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions and availability of appropriate skills and experience among staff, company profile and financial and legal status).

Bids from interested and reputable firms should meet the following minimum requirements.

- 1. Cover letter submitting the expression of interest
- 2. Copy of registration certificate
- 3. Copy of valid tax compliance certificate
- 4. Copy of VAT and Pin certificate
- 5. Audited financial statement for the last three years.
- 6. Recommendations by at least three public/private institutions served with similar works.

For the purpose of demonstrating experience in the expression of interest, consultants should list at least three (3) and at most five (5) successful similar project implementation experiences in each of the items (i) (ii) and (iii) below, clearly indicating the year undertaken, the country, name of the client and project/report acceptance confirmation by the client:

- i) General experience of Consultant in dam, irrigation and water supply supervision projects for not less than 5 years
- ii) Specific experience of consultant in Design and Supervision of dam projects or similar projects
- iii) Experience of the Consultant in Arid and Semi-Arid Lands (ASAL).

Consultants may constitute joint-ventures to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality & Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) Method at the next stage of Request for proposals (RFP)

The Client will prepare a short list of a maximum of six (6) firms to be pre-selected on the basis of the Expression of Interest (EOI) received to whom a Request of Proposals (RFP) will be sent. All participating firms will be provided with feedback of the evaluation.
